



POOL REGULATIONS

AC Hotel by Marriott Kraków

Dimensions of the pool: 12m x 17m x 1,4m

Average pool temperature: 29°C

1. Every person uses the pool facilities at their own responsibility and is considered to have read and acknowledged the following set of rules and is obliged to behave accordingly.
2. The pool is available to hotel guests and individual clients from Monday to Friday from 07:00 to 21:00 and at weekends from 9:00 to 21:00.
3. The swimming pool does not have lifeguard supervision.
4. Guests use the swimming pool at their own risk. The hotel is not responsible for accidents and injuries.
5. While at the pool facilities the users are obliged to wear flip-flops and a swim suit or trunks. Shoes and clothes must be left in the locker rooms.
6. All the items that have sharp edges (e.g. jewellery) and items that can be damaged easily (e.g. cel phones, watches) should be left in the locker rooms. However, it is advised to leave such items at home or in the hotel room to lessen the risk of theft. The AC by Marriott Kraków Staff does not take responsibility for the stolen or lost items.
7. Prior to using the pool facilities one must use the shower and disinfect feet.
8. It is forbidden to bring in and consume any food or drinks in the pool area.
9. It is forbidden to bring in and consume alcoholic drinks or smoking near and in the pool area.
10. AC by MARRIOTT Kraków declares the right to refuse admittance to the pool facilities to anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
11. Anyone whose behaviour might be dangerous to other users of the pool facilities or anyone whose condition might result in drowning, may be asked to leave the premises.



12. All injuries or mood aggravation that have occurred at the swimming pool must be reported to the lifeguard or the receptionist immediately.
13. Children under 16 may use the pool facility only under adult supervision.
14. Children under 3 years of age using the pool must wear disposable diaper and bathing panties.
15. In the pool area it is forbidden to:
 - a) Run in the pool hall, locker rooms and shower area,
 - b) Jump or throw others into water,
 - c) Use the pool while having any bandage on you,
 - d) Destroy the pool equipment,
 - e) Make noise and alarm the lifeguard with no reason.
16. Anyone who purposefully contaminates the pool will be charged with the costs of water replacement. In case of children, their caregiver will take full responsibility. Also, anyone who damages any equipment will be charged with all repair costs.
17. Disabled persons using the swimming pool and in wheelchairs are required to report to the hotel Staff.
18. Hotel AC by MARRIOTT Kraków is not responsible for any body injuries and accidents from violation of the regulations..
