Cap Classique

Methode Cap Classique is the Cape version of the authentic Champagne style. The wines undergo the important secondary fermentation in the bottle, and are engorged in the traditional way, yet yield a unique flavour and style. A Brut wine is nearly dry and contains no more than 1.5% sugar.

Boschendal Brut NV

Pale gold with a flourish of delicate bubbles and enticing lemon cream and almond Biscotti precede lovely layers of citrus and a finish with appealing length and freshness.

Boschendal Brut Rosé NV

This Brut Rosé captivates with its delicate pale pink colour and intoxicating red fruit aromas which further delight the palate with hints of strawberry, raspberry and cherry flavours.

Boschendal Luxe Nectar NV

A flourish of delicate bubbles brings forth the decadent crème brulee and almond biscotti deliciousness, balanced with alluring lemon cream and orange peel to finish with vibrant freshness and length.

Krone Borealis Cuvée Brut

This reveals vibrant layers of green and red apples, white peaches, kiwis and hints of lemon curd with a chalky mid-palate to hold the lacy, mouth-coating mousse.

Krone Night Nectar NV

Delicate notes of blossom, honeycomb, gingerbread and glacé pineapple run through layers of pear, yellow apples, and white sultanas balanced with a wash of lime.

Pierre Jourdan Blanc De Blanc Brut NV

Created in the traditional French method of bottle fermentation known as Cap Classique in South Africa, the palate is lively with fresh lime and orange characteristics, and hints of oak.

Pierre Jourdan Brut Belle Rosé NV

Created in the traditional French method of bottle fermentation known as Cap Classique in South Africa, enjoy a full nose of strawberries and cream, followed by fresh acidity and red fruit on the palate.

Pongrácz Brut NV

Crisp green apple notes and nuttiness of freshly baked bread are prevalent on the nose.

Simonsig Kaapse Vonkel Brut Rosé NV

This vibrant Cap Classique has an energetic, yet delicate and persistent mousse. On the nose, captivating aromas of field flowers, red apples and strawberries.

Pale gold with delicate bubbles and light biscuity aromas with hints of grapefruit, apple, and orange peel. White peach, lemon, and apple, with mineral and smoky undertones dance on the palate of this popular French champagne.

WHITE WINES

Sauvignon Blanc

Meant to be drunk young, this is the most tangy and pungent of the wine varietals. Typical characteristics are green peppers, freshly mowed lawns and tropical fruits.

Douglas Green

Pale gold with a vibrant green tinge. Overt pineapple, gooseberry and granadilla aromas carry through to a crisp dry entry and a surge of tangy tropical flavours that finish with a feisty acidity and delicate citrus twang.

Glass: R80 | Bottle: R210

Brampton

Expressive tropical fruit salad aromas leap out of the glass, followed by underlying green fig and apple notes. Fruit forward with a rich tropical mid-palate of guava and passion fruit.

Backsberg Hillside

Brimming with notes of sweet melon, kiwi and Cape gooseberry, this thirst-quenching Sauvignon Blanc will heighten your senses.

R290

Durbanville Hills

Lively aromas of zesty lime, complemented by yellow fruit, blackcurrant, gooseberries, ripe asparagus, guava and custard apple.

R265

La Motte

Unwooded, with a fragrant tropical bouquet and a distinctive gooseberry middle palate. Firm and full-flavoured with a crisp, elegant finish.

R305

Guardian Peak

A classically styled Sauvignon Blanc with bold aromas of cut grass, passion fruit, guava and kiwi.

R370

Rustenberg Stellenbosch Wild Ferment

Much loved for its freshness, mouth watering acidity and upfront fruit. Rustenberg makes a slightly fuller richer style of Sauvignon Blanc without relying on the influence of oak.

Warwick The First Lady

Tasty and flavourful with subtle passionfruit, lime, and green apple aromatics.

R320

Chenin Blanc

Less commonly also known locally as Steen, South Africa has more vineyards planted to Chenin Blanc than its traditional home in the Loire Valley, France. This is a highly acidic wine that can range from very dry to very sweet and is often the base for brandy or dessert wines.

Douglas Green

Pale gold with a vibrant green glow. Exuberant passion fruit, ripe peaches and pineapple on first impression embellished with honey suckle grace that carries through to a generous yet well-tempered palate.

Glass: R80 | Bottle: R210

Franschhoek Cellar

Animated pear and pineapple, fleshy peach, nectarine and litchi aromas supported by a line of bright citrus and tropical fruit that blossom with leesy intrigue on the palate, and finish with zesty freshness and grace.

Fryer's Cove

This Chenin Blanc is bright with acidity that supports mouth-watering flavours of lemon, nectarine and white peach

R425

Gaurdian Peak

Expressive aromas of golden delicious apples, spicy pear, lemon verbena and jasmine. Light and fresh on the palate, with zesty acidity, notes of apples and peach iced tea, with a crisp finish of lime cordial.

Chardonnay

Considered the world's most popular white wine variety, its passionate following has an equally vehement group who will go to great lengths to avoid drinking it. Usually oaked, typical chardonnay characteristics are nuances of buttered popcorn, citrus fruits and vanilla (from the wood extract).

Douglas Green

Bright gold with youthful flashes of green. Tropical pineapple and honey melon aromas explode on entry yielding cohesive delicate lemon lime flavours tinged with subtle oak complexity and a generous yet graceful zesty fruit finish.

Glass: R80 | Bottle: R210

Franschhoek Cellar

Radiant pale gold with a youthful green glow. Attractive pineapple and lemon & lime fruit purity with and intensity on both the nose and palate.

Brampton Unoaked

This Brampton Unoaked Chardonnay is pale yellow with a green tint. Citrus and lime on the nose as well as a hint of pear, peach and winter melon.

Spier Signature

Aromas of citrus with hints of apple, peach and white pear.

Rustenberg Five Soldiers

Characters of ripe citrus, melon and peach with great minerality, rounded out by well-judged oaking. A very complex wine with a long and creamy finish and a good acid backbone.

White Blends

White wine blends are like a masterful mixtape—each grape brings its own vibe to the party, creating something greater than the sum of its parts. Whether it's a crisp, citrusy combo or a lush, tropical fusion, these blends can swing from bone-dry to just-a-hint-of-sweet. And while they may not blush like rosé, they're just as refreshing when served ice-cold, making them the ultimate sip for sunny days, lazy picnics, or whenever you need a liquid high-five for your taste buds.

Douglas Green Chenin Blanc Sauvignon Blanc

Bright gold with a youthful green glow. Brimming with a fruit salad of aromas including tropical pineapple, papaya, guava and granadilla with a subtle streak of green asparagus and figs that follow through on an accommodating mouthful of sunny ripe flavours, perfectly balanced by a frisky dry finish with lingering citrus freshness.

Glass: R80 | Bottle: R210

Boschendal Boschen Blanc

Lively green with straw tinge. Tropical fruit and citrus aromas. Vibrant citrus infused with some pear drop sweetness. A hint of honeysuckle, finishing with a balanced elegance.

Glass: R85 | Bottle: R235

Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc

This full bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters including ripe gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.

Semi-Sweet Wines

Sunkissed Natural Sweet White

Relish extravagant sunny lemon, lime and pineapple fruit aromas and flavours laced with delicious honey and spice in this soft, sweet and fruity blend.

Glass: R80 | Bottle: R210

Drostdy Hof Adelpracht

This blend is full and rich with flavours of dried apricots and peaches and a touch of honey.

Glass: R80 | Bottle: R210

Boschendal Le Bouquet

Tropical pineapple-led fruit and peach with spicy undertones, and a lingering floral aroma of honeysuckle and frangipani. This medium-sweet wine has a delicate freshness and a juicy fruit core, embracing characters of peach and apricot with hints of cinnamon and honey.

SHADES OF PINK

Blush Wines

Rosé and Blanc de Noir use different methods to attain their soft pink strawberry colours. The styles can vary from bone dry to semi sweet. Regardless of whether it is dry or semi-sweet, Rose or Blanc de Noir is always served well chilled and thus makes a wonderfully refreshing summertime drink.



Boschendal Blanc De Noir

This wine presents complex red berry fruit notes. An appealing pale salmon colour leads to bright red fruit, strawberry and red berries.

Boschendal The Rose Garden Rosé

Enticing crushed summer berry aromas. Soft and juicy, bouncing with succulent ripe strawberries, raspberries and mulberries tinged with a hint of spice.

Haute Cabrière Pinot Noir Rosé

Incredible colour of salmon pink, with a candyfloss sheen. This wine has a generous mouthfeel and a soft finish. Enjoy this elegant, dry rosé throughout the year with its aromas of strawberries and rose petals.

De Krans Pinotage Rosé

Soft elegant rose petal, candyfloss nose with hints of strawberries. Smooth and quenching palate with fine red fruit flavours and a fresh acidity.

Nederburg Rosé

This wine showcases lovely aromas of rose petals and strawberries with a hint of candy floss. Intense flavours of red berries with a dash of sweetness.

RED WINES

Shiraz

A rich, spice wine with loads of tannins and the sweetness of blackberries. Shiazor Syrah has its traditional home in Rhone, France. Styles vary from blockbuster, show-stoppers to the more austere and subtle.

Douglas Green

Dark ruby with a bright crimson rim. Enticing blackcurrant pastilles and blueberries embellished by a subtle oak spice.

Glass: R90 | Bottle: R235

Bellingham Homestead

This Shiraz displays a captivating deep ruby-red hue, inviting the senses with its rich aromas of ripe plum, blackcurrant, and subtle undertones of pepper, chocolate, and mixed spices.

R305

Guardian Peak

Approachable Shiraz with pronounced nose of ripe plum and juicy black currant with some spicy notes of cinnamon, cloves and a hint of black pepper.

Pinotage

South Africa's own cultivator produced by crossing Pinot Noir with Cinsaut in the 1920's. Pinotage is made in a range of styles from simply fruity to ambitious, well oaked examples and has nuances of forest-floor, earthy tones and dense fruits.

Douglas Green

Attractive crimson depth with a purple hue on the rim. Generous ripe strawberry and raspberry fruit on the nose brushed with dark chocolate and caramel hints.

Glass: R90 | Bottle: R240

Bellingham Homestead

The wine presents an intense dark red core with a ruby rim, showcasing aromas of sweet spices, plums, and mulberries, complemented by subtle hints of vanilla.

The Fat Man by ORWCo.

The Fat Man is generous and inviting on entry, with juicy red berries and plums with hints of milk chocolate, oregano and spice.

Beyerskloof

Pleasant plum and blackberry aromas upfront with lovely cedar oak in the background.

Merlot

The wine made famous (or infamous) by the Hollywood film, *Sideways*, Merlot is usually higher in alcohol than other red wines and has nuances of black cherries and mint with an inky-purple colour.

Douglas Green

Bright garnet with a bright strawberry rim. Packed with juicy black cherry and fleshy plum aromas that tumble softly across the palate with plush mulberry and spice flavours interwoven with soft, ripe tannins and subtle oak intrigue for a smooth and juicy finish.

Glass: R90 | Bottle: R240

Backsberg Plum Valley

Plump and well-rounded, this smooth red Merlot is a bundle of vinous energy with prominent notes of plum, cherry, chocolate and raspberry soaring from the glass.

R370

Franschhoek Cellar

Bright ruby red with attractive plum and black cherry aromas tinged with herbal tea, liquorice and gentle oak spice. Soft and juicy with mouth-filling summer berry flavours that finish smoothly with sour cherry succulence.

R285

Durbanville Hills

A medium-bodied wine with a velvety smooth tannin structure that boasts ripe red berries on the palate. Red cherries and raspberries are prominent.

R255

Protea

With silky smooth, delicate tannins that fill the tongue, this full-bodied merlot wine is a masterpiece. Bright blue and black berry fruit aromas combined with subtle cocoa undertones and a faint leafy brush express harmony and elegance that linger long after the last sip.

R335

Guardian Peak

A balanced, medium bodied Merlot with mulberry, plum, and toast on the nose. Soft tannins enhance the juicy fruit on the palate, with cherries and plums accented by notes of sage and liquorice.

R415

Cabernet Sauvignon

Thick-skinned grapes with loads of tannin, Cabernet Sauvignon nuances include that of mint, chocolate, black cherries, blackcurrants, cigar box and warm spices. Cabernet makes some of the world's finest and longest lasting wines and can be either used as a single varietal or as a blend (the most famous being the Bordeaux-blend wines).

Douglas Green

Deep ruby with a bright edge. Intense dark berries and blackcurrant aromas with attractive gentle smoky oak notes.

Glass: R85 | Bottle: R235

Brampton

The wine has a rich ruby colour with a dense core of red cherry, mulberry and blackcurrant flavours.

R295

Boschendal Stellenbosch

Aromas of ripe black cherry and cassis, pencil shavings, cigar box accents and spice make an enticing entry, and linger onto the palate, where chalky tannins and a rich, textured mouthfeel also become noticable.

Warwick The First Lady

Grapes are tank-fermented, allowing the vibrant, rich, ripe blackcurrant and plum fruit to sit front and center.

R505

Anthonij Rupert

This is an impressive, structured but rewarding wine. The integration of wood and fruit is impressive and it is beautifully balanced and long.

Red Blends

Red blends are the ultimate wine-world mashup—where bold Cabernet, spicy Syrah, and sultry Merlot come together to create something greater than the sum of their parts. Some are fruit-forward and jammy, others structured and complex, but all bring serious depth and personality to the glass.

Douglas Green Merlot Melbec

A bright crimson heart with deep ruby rim. Lashings of crushed summer berries and fleshy plum aromas with supple, succulent, generous ripe berry favours brushed with soft oak spice to a sleek juicy fruit finish.

Glass: R85 | Bottle: R240

The Cattleman's Club

Pinotage, Shiraz & Merlot

The oak must be noticeable, but not dominant, the Shiraz must be chunky and robust, the Pinotage fruit ripe and smooth.

Roxton by Brampton

Petit Verdot, Shiraz & Malbec

The Malbec adds bright berry-fruit. This wine displays delicious dark black cherries with dark chocolate and spice on the mid-palate and a lingering finish.

Boschendal Nicolas

Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Merlot, Malbec, Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot

On the nose red cherries, fresh plums, mulberries and cassis are complimented by pencil-shavings, dark chocolate and spicy cigar box flavours.

R555

Kanonkop Kadette Cape Blend

Pinotage, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot

Bright deep ruby red colour. The nose shows cassis, raspberries, cherries, black plums, cinnamon, allspice and a hint of chocolate.

R390

Nederburg Baronne

Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz & Other varieties
Cohesive and rewarding with everything where it should be. Ripe and rounded fruitiness, juicy from lively acidity, well framed and structured by tannin and with a length of flavour that keeps going.

R290

Rupert & Rothschild Classique

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot & Melbec

Alluring aromas are lead with a vibrant floral expression, followed by generous black cherries, plum, and blackcurrant.

R670

Meerlust Rubicon

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot

A youthful deep ruby red colour. A complex perfume of violets, ripe black plum, blackberry, cassis with cedar wood, bouquet garni and potpourri spice. Still young and intense, the palate is full bodied, packed with fresh dark fruit and rounded tannins and seamlessly integrated oak and a lifted acidity. This wine offers balance and elegance.

FRANSCHOEK CELLAR

the last elephant

The town of Franschhoek was originally called Oliphant's Hoek meaning Elephant's Corner, and named after the herds of elephant that once roamed the surrounding valley and mountains.

The original mountains pass out of Franschhoek was built on an old elephant trail that carried these majestic creatures between their summer and their winter pastures.

To this day the Franschhoek Valley holds the elephant dear as a symbol of the power and finesse that mark the wines born of its fertile earth.

The last elephant was seen leaving the valley late in the 19th Century, inspiring this characterful, evocative wine.



The Last Elephant

Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot & Petit Verdot

The nose brims with moreish dark fruit, showing blackcurrants, cherries, mulberries along with cedar wood, lead pencil and cigar box aromas.
