

## Slide Rules

Length: 84.7 meters

Width: 1000 mm (millimeters)

Elevation Difference: 9.70 meters

Slope: 12%

Water Flow: 120 m<sup>3</sup>/h (cubic meters per hour)

1. The slide is an integral part of the Pool Area. Users of the slide are subject to the provisions of the Pool Area Regulations.
2. Except for children under 7 years old, the slide is available to all other Pool Area users who can swim.
3. Children under the age of 13 can only use the slide under the constant supervision of parents or legal guardians.
4. In the event of adverse weather conditions, in particular air temperatures below  $-5^{\circ}\text{C}$  and atmospheric discharges (lightning), the water slide shall remain closed until further notice.
5. The use of the slide is at the own risk of the authorized user.
6. Only one person is allowed on the starting platform.
7. The slide is subject to compliance with the information provided by the traffic light signal located above the entrance to the slide tube, where its indications mean:
  - a. green color - sliding allowed, permission to enter the slide tube;
  - b. red color - sliding prohibited, entry into the slide tube is prohibited;
8. Before sliding, check if there is water flowing in the tube. Dry sliding is strictly prohibited.
9. It is prohibited to create situations endangering:
  - 8.1. one's own safety,
  - 8.2. the safety of other users of the Pool Area slide,
    - 8.3. that could lead to an unfortunate accident, including, in particular:
      - 8.3.1. using the slide when the traffic light signal is not functioning,
      - 8.3.2. closing access with a chain, rope, barrier, or in any other visible way,
      - 8.3.3. starting the slide when the traffic light signal is red,
      - 8.3.4. pushing users into the interior of the slide tube,
      - 8.3.5. sliding in pairs, in a group, or with small children, especially holding them in the arms on the stomach,
      - 8.3.6. bringing any objects into the chute and sliding down with objects that could cause bodily harm, including: glasses, jewelry (watches, rings, bracelets, necklaces, earrings, hair ornaments), and swimming equipment (boards, armbands, and swimming goggles, etc.).
      - 8.3.7. jumping into the slide tube with a running start,
      - 8.3.8. stopping and standing inside the slide tube,
      - 8.3.9. unjustified braking during the descent,
      - 8.3.10. climbing on railings, handrails, structural elements
      - 8.3.11 entering the slide tube from the end element's side and climbing inside the tube toward the starting point is strictly prohibited.
10. Sliding is done individually.
11. The start is done in a seated position with legs pointing downward. The only allowed sliding position is lying on your back with legs straight, facing in the direction of the slide, and arms positioned alongside the body. Other sliding positions are prohibited.
12. After sliding, you must immediately leave the landing area.
13. The supervision of compliance with this regulation is carried out by lifeguards and Pool Area staff.
14. All users using the slide are required to strictly follow the instructions of lifeguards and Pool Area staff.
15. Users who do not comply with the provisions of this regulation will be removed from the Pool Area.
16. All complaints and requests should be reported to the Pool Area Reception staff or at the Main Reception of Hotel Warszawianka.
