HERITAGE SITES AND TOURS



Malindi Marine National Park

Ksh 7900pp | Full Day Tour (minimum of 4 guests per tour)

Malindi Marine National Park is Africa's first marine park and one of the world's last great natural marine reserves. Glowing with coral gardens and teeming with vividly fantastic fish, the park provides a haven for divers and a window into the wonders of the deep for snorkelers, swimmers, and rock pool dabblers alike.



Mombasa Tour

Ksh 7200pp | Full Day Tour (minimum of 4 guests per tour)

Mombasa is a place steeped in history, yet, at the same time, a fascinating commercial and cosmopolitan port town. It is an island connected to the mainland by bridges and ferries. The town overlooks a wide harbour, where commercial shipping mingles with traditional sailing shows.

Arabuko Sukoke Forest contains three unique forest types; mixed forest, Brachystegia and Cynometra; each of which protects a different population of plants, animals, and 230 species of birds.



Jumba La Mtwana Ruins

Ksh 4500pp | Half Day Tour (minimum 2 guests per tour)

Jumba la Mtwana is Swahili for "the large house of the slave". Within this area, four mosques, a tomb and four houses have survived in recognisable condition. As you gaze at the ocean washing over the beach, you can't help but wonder what really happened here.




Gede Ruins and Mida Creek
